As the new legislative session begins in Oklahoma, there are a few items Sooner State Abate is addressing.

Senate Bill 1457: Senator Shorty This bill is to help stop motorcyclists from being pulled over or denied access based on what they wear or what they ride.

SB 1077 Senator Fry This bill is designed to clarify the use of auxiliary accent lighting (LED) on motorcycles. Current state motor vehicle code does not cover the use of LEDs. Which leaves it up to law enforcement to decide if they feel you are legal or not.

SB1277 Senator Sharp This bill will create a Sooner State, Oklahoma license plate for motor cycles and cars This will be available to all who what to show their support.

There are 5 other bills that might interest everyone are:

Support : SB 838 Senator Loveless, his bill changes the law that the allows the state to take and sell your stuff BEFORE you are convicted of a crime. To AFTER you are convicted. This is a no brainer, that is the way it should have been.

Defeat: S B 1009 Senator Matthews. This bill is to change to the Stand your ground law, which allows you to defend you and your family from death without question.

Is to be changed to require you to retreat first and only as a last resort to use deadly force. It will be the opinion of the investigating officer and/or the D.A. if you were able to retreat (run) if they FEEL you could have ran for it and didn't, then YOU

will charged.

Defeat: House Bill 2275 Representative Denny wants to collect DNA from anyone arrested for a felony. NOT convicted, just arrested (and how you are charged is up to the arresting officer). Also who is paying for processing and storage of samples, you are.

Defeat: SB 972 Senator Smalley creating a new class of vehicles.

The autocycle, is reverse trike enclosed cab no M endorsement.

Problem they r removing the cab requirement, which could include ALL 3 wheel motorcycles, there goes the death toll and insurance rates

Problem 2-9 requires more government to regulate, tax, rewrite laws, set up bonding for Autocycle dealers repair centers. Plus if trikes are included do u want seatbelts, autocycles have.

And everone who is already trying to run us down in a cage will now be able to have a toy to make it worse out there.

Your Opinion: HB 2260 As written 2/10/16 It will require everyone under 18 to take a MSF Basic riding course to get their license. Training is good, but forcing people to use a certain company is against state law/ constitution I do believe. Ask your politician they should know.



## Hoobee's Safety Corner

Greeting my SOONER STATE ABATE Brother and Sisters, if you winterized your bike by following my last Safety Corner Article, you will have either drained the fuel or added a fuel stabilizer to the fuel in the tank. If you did drain your tank, use a flashlight and take a peek inside for any rust, gunk, or condensation that could cause problems later, if you notice any drain you tank and refill your tank with high-octane fuel before you start it up, to make sure the gas running through the system is as fresh as possible. Stale gasoline is an often forgotten yet very problematic issue with stored vehicles.

The most common issue with bikes sitting all winter long tends to be the batteries. Every time a battery goes dead, its life gets cut down, and it only needs to be drained a few times for it to become really problematic. Smart riders will have kept their battery on a while it was stored, but if you forgot this step,

it's not too late to order one and charge your battery back up for that first ride of the season. I recommend getting a "smart" battery charger that automatically turns itself off so you don't overcharge and damage it. No matter what charger you pick up, it's still a good idea to check your battery fluid levels before hooking it up, and top off any low cells. If you have a lithium battery, you'll need to treat it a little differently. You should still use a trickle charger, but you'll need one that is lithium battery-specific. Lithium batteries are solid-state, so you don't top off the cells with water either. If you happen to hook up your battery to a charger and nothing happens, chances are that your battery is just too far gone to be revived. It's definitely better to check the battery in advance!

Tires are a part of your bike that should really be checked before every ride. When checking tires after storage, you should be conscious of potential

flat-spotting on the tires from sitting for a long time and bringing tire pressure up to spec, as air will have undoubtedly seeped out after months of not being used. Check the tire wear too, it may be a good time to go ahead and replace tires before spring hits, so you know you have good rubber for the whole riding season. You may have changed your oil as part of your winterizing process, but if not, it's a good idea to change it before starting a new riding season. Next check your brake fluid, and top off the fluid levels in your master cylinder, ensuring you use the correct brake fluid for your bike, different DOT brake fluids should not be mixed. Ideally, you should do a complete flush of your brake system with new fluid. Remember your coolant if your bike has it, make sure coolant levels are up to spec, especially after your bike's been sitting for several months. If you really want to go the extra mile, you can do a complete coolant flush also, clearing out

all the used coolant with white vinegar and distilled water, and refilling your system with a fresh mix. If your bike tends to run hot or you ride especially hard, check out products like engine ice a racing-approved coolant that can reduce operating temperatures by 20 degrees or more. Unless you're working on making a Rat Bike, give your bike a good scrub and wax it up to help protect it from riding season hazards such as dirt, rocks and even the sun. Now with the battery charged, fresh fuel in the tank, all moving parts lubed up, and a paint job that sparkles in the springtime sunlight, there's only one thing left to do - go ride!

## Oklahoma Cofederation of Clubs Liason Report

The Oklahoma 2016 Legislative Session Began February 1. Many thanks to OKCOC Members, US Defenders, and Coalition of Independent Riders (COIR) for attending the OKCOC M.E.A.L. (Motorcyclists Educating & Affecting Legislation) on Thursday, Feb. 11 at the State House. Attendees got to both distribute breakfast items to Legislators and their staffs and spend time discussing important issues with them. Lil Wolf Ministries received a Citation of Appreciation from the OK State Senate for their assistance of Camp Iron Horse during the May 2013 Tornado Disaster. The next M.E.A.L. is scheduled for Thursday, May 12, 9:00AM at the Capitol Third Floor Balcony. All concerned Americans are urged to participate.

Legislative update: SB1457, the Anti-Profiling Bill, wasn't heard in committee. A US Defenders Call to Action was issued to get your legislators to contact Sen. Ralph Shortey with support, and to possibly get the issue attached to another bill. The alternative will be to carry it forward to the 2017 Session. SB1077, which would ease restrictions on auxiliary/decorative motorcycle lighting, also wasn't heard in committee. This bill will also be brought forward to 2017 if not attached to another bill. SB1277, creating Sooner State ABATE License Plates for bikes and cars, is moving forward. ALERT: SB2260 is still alive, and needs to be defeated. This bill would mandate MSF Rider Training Courses for riders under 18. The problem with this is it would State-sanction a specific Private Corporation to conduct Rider Ed Courses for profit. Also, RFID Chip Drivers Licenses are delayed

for Oklahoma per the REAL-ID Act, and current licenses can still be used with TSA at airports. We'll provide updates. Finally, per Title 47, if your vehicle has ANY kind of Disabled Plate, a Handicapped Placard is NOT required! P.S. [www.soonerstateabate.com](http://www.soonerstateabate.com) and [okcoc.com](http://okcoc.com) will have links to the Legislative Websites so Bikers can obtain the contact information needed for their elected officials.

On the National Scene, the 31st Annual NCOM Convention is slated for May 5-8, 2016 at Harrah's Resort in Atlantic City NJ. Check out [www.onabike.com](http://www.onabike.com) for pre-registration and travel information. The easiest way to fly into Atlantic City is to go to Philadelphia PA, and NCOM is going to provide a 56-passenger shuttle both ways. We'll have a full slate of educational and informative seminars coming up, and key issues will be discussed, including Nationwide Anti-Profiling Legislation, Saving the Right to wear Patch Insignia, and the Waco Horror. NCOM will provide Convention Agendas soon.

The Wheels of Justice are turning slowly regarding Waco TX, and all are eating for updates on those indicted. Waco Victims and their families are still enduring great hardship regarding homes, jobs and finances. NCOM Christian Unity and TX-COC&I have been reaching out with support. You can donate by contacting TXCOC&I Shield of Faith PO Box 2321, Cedar Park TX 78630 or go to: <http://sofaog.org/waco-aide>. There's a PayPal link for donations, where 99.44 percent of every dollar goes to the victims. The organizations collecting money are 501c-3 for tax purposes. I'm getting more Waco

Memorial Patches, as I'm sold out. Thanks to our Riding Community for purchasing these--100 percent of the funding goes to the victims, through NCOM Christian Unity Texas, who's getting a special award at the NCOM Convention for their efforts. Louie Nobs, Christian Unity Liaison, is receiving this year's Ron Roloff Lifetime Achievement award for his hard work. The NCOM Board will have to cope with Gimmi Jimmy and Paul Landers stepping down from their COC, US Defenders and NCOM Legislative Task Force Positions, but we're glad that they'll keep supporting the COC in some capacity. I've been proud to have worked with them to defend Biker Liberty, and respect & honor their service and sacrifice.

I'm still waiting for Save the Patch updates on sanctions being imposed on the prosecution for the Mongols case, and how the case against the Devils Disciples is progressing. On Feb. 26, the Second District Appellate Court (IL) ruled that three Outlaws MC patch vests were "Derivative Contraband" and could be seized by the state! The ruling affirmed a lower court decision--essentially, "gang experts" testified that the vests portray "violent intimidation" and were used to facilitate "street gang activity". The judge ruled the vests "weren't inherently illegal, but used in a unlawful manner". Basically, the First Amendment takes a back seat to a "crime" according to "gang expert" testimony. It's worth your while to read up on this case--it's implication is really scary! The decision to appeal further hasn't been announced.

OKCOC Members went to Joplin MO Feb. 21 to plan further the 25th Annual Mid-South MILE Motorcycling Rights Seminars scheduled for Oct. 14-16, probably at the Doubletree Hotel in Joplin. We're lining up a variety of diverse topics, and all six member states (Louisiana has just joined) will be represented. We're also lining up speakers from the AMA, MRF, NCOM and MAG-Belgium. Check [www.midsouthmile.org](http://www.midsouthmile.org) for updates and a pre-registration form.

Finally, I want to recognize the passing of a dear friend, Wilburn C. "Capt Bill" Hall, who just passed away from cancer. Bill was an avid motorcyclist for a lot of years. We are celebrating in 2016 the Twentieth Anniversary of the Oklahoma Confederation of Clubs, and Bill Hall was one of our first legal representatives in the mid-90s as an NCOM Attorney. Bill was passionate about Biker Liberty. He was instrumental in pushing a successful lawsuit over Motorcycle-Only Checkpoints at the VNV MC State Rally in Turner Falls. This legal action was the first victory for the OKCOC, and is the forerunner of our current campaign to get Anti-Profiling Legislation passed in Oklahoma. He survived a really bad motorcycle wreck a few years back, & we fell out of touch. Bill was a great guy, & I'll really miss him. Ride Free Forever, Bill Hall! With deep Respects & Condolences to family & friends, Tiger Mike
